- In exceptional cases, we are entitled to process your personal data based on the legitimate interest of our company, customers or employees to protect their rights and property, namely in the case of insurance claims or legal disputes to establish, exercise and defend legal claims where litigation is pending or imminent, an insurance claim has occurred, or a tort has been committed.
